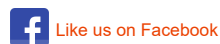

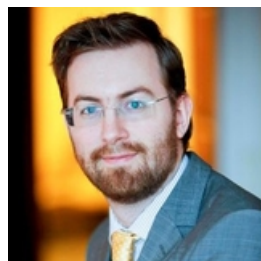

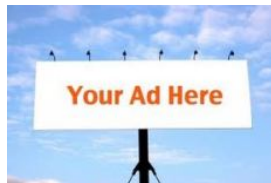

Some of these include Vertic, HelloMonday, SpoiledMilk, Prehype, Trustpilot, Mirsk, in2media, Qualiware, Colourbox, Koalition and Alfapeople.
