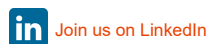

Make sure to save the date for Friday June 13, where we hope to kick off an annual tradition - a pinsefrokost (the traditional Danish Pentecost lunch).

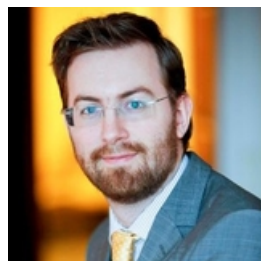
