### Nordic Artwork

Nordic Artwork is a Danish online gallery in New York promoting unique artwork by nine established artists residing in Denmark. The gallery is representing the artistic energy that is emerging from Scandinavia today, as depicted by these talented and well-known Danish artists. The two Danish natives, Kirsten Wildfang and Tine Kryger, have retained strong ties to their Scandinavian and artistic roots, and their goal is to bring style and inspiration to the United States with the clean lines of Nordic art.

The gallery was founded in 2013 and has already shown the works by André Lundquist, Christina Blaabjerg, Christina Kjelsmark, Fadavi, Frank Buchgraitz, Gerda Louise Buchgraitz, Hanne Støvring, Janusz Tyrpak and Martin Eggert at various locations within the New York Tri-State area, as well as the San Francisco area. Currently, the gallery is showing works by all of the nine artists at The Consulate General of Denmark New York as well as The Danish Mission to the United Nations. Nordic Artwork was honored in April 2014 by the American Scandinavian Society as the "American Scandinavian Cultural Grant Recipient" of a special endorsement in recognition of the work Kirsten Wildfang and Tine Kryger do to promote Danish art in the Tri-State area.

Furthermore, Nordic Artwork was chosen to participate in the prestigious ArtHamptons art fair in July 2014, where more than 15,000 art lovers flocked to view the exhibits of 87 international galleries.
